# Service Award

#### Service Award Purpose and Eligibility

- Recognize outstanding diversity and inclusion accomplishments of faculty, staff, and students in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences (CALS).
  - Nominees for the award should exemplify excellence in advancing the college's mission of promoting diversity in the college.
- Eligibility
  - Faculty and staff nominees must be current employees in CALS.
  - Student nominees must be enrolled in a CALS undergraduate or graduate program and expected to graduate in the academic year of the award.
  - Self-nominations are encouraged.
  - Previous winners cannot apply in the same award category (faculty, staff, or student).

#### Service Award Criteria

- Award recipients will have demonstrated a thorough understanding of, appreciation for, and advocacy of diversity issues. Successful nominees will have:
  - Taken a leadership role at the the university, college, unit, department, or district level to improve the quality of life and service in the academic or the broader community
  - Actively sought to increase their knowledge of current inclusion and diversity topics
  - Provided or actively participated in opportunities to raise awareness of diversity and inclusion within the community in which they live, study, or work.
  - Demonstrated a commitment to equity and fairness in the treatment of all, and ensure their access to opportunities and resources.
  - Spoken on behalf of diversity in their community, unit, or department in order to promote understanding of and sensitivity to diversity issues among colleagues.
  - Assisted in the recruitment and retention of diverse faculty, staff, students, and volunteers.
  - Conducted diversity research and scholarly activities that enhance the college's diversity and inclusion initiatives.
- Applications due April 22, 2022 at 5p via Submittable

#### Service Award Application Process and Evaluation

#### • Application will include:

- Nomination information,
- Description of how the nominee has exemplified excellence in advancing CALS mission of promoting diversity and inclusion
- Letter of support (optional)
- Nomination statement (from the nominee or a second party optional)
- A committee consisting of members of the CALS Diversity Council will review the applications and make the award selections.
- If there are no applications that demonstrate outstanding diversity accomplishments, the council reserves the right to not select a winner.

# **Incentive Award**

#### Incentive Award Purpose and Award Categories

- Support opportunities that increase the understanding of, appreciation for, and advocacy of diversity issues at the intersection with our agriculture and life sciences work.
- Three categories:
  - Research awards should focus on conducting research (e.g. collecting or analyzing data, or creating equitable research opportunities) and/or developing research practices through the lens of diversity, inclusion, and equity.
  - Teaching awards should focus on teaching practices and/or student- or instructor-focused educational opportunities which address diversity, inclusion, and equity.
  - Extension/outreach awards should focus on planning, conducting, and evaluating extension/outreach activities which integrate aspects of diversity, inclusion, and equity for internal and/or external audiences.

#### **Incentive Award Application Process**

- Who can apply?
  - Faculty, staff, students, and student organizations may apply
  - At least one member of the proposed program team must be a current CALS faculty, staff, or student enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program of the college at the time of the nomination and for the period of the funded activity
  - Previous recipients can reapply for funding
- Submittable
- Applications due April 29th at 5:00p

#### **Incentive Award Proposal Evaluation**

#### • Two rounds of evaluation

- First round to review what is presented, and the committee may ask clarifying questions or offer feedback for submitters to consider and modify the proposal
- Second round to make award determinations
- Proposals evaluated based on how well the committee determines the application questions are answered and responses to first round questions/feedback

#### **Incentive Award Timeline**

- Applications due April 29, 2022 at 5:00p EDT via Submittable
- Committee will convene for first round review, ask questions and offer feedback to authors
- Authors will have an opportunity to respond to questions/feedback over the course of a few weeks
- Committee will convene for second round of review and make final determinations
- Authors notified of Committee's decisions in Summer 2022

## Award Funding

Requests may be made for up to \$2,000. The committee intends to make one award for each category. However, the committee may make multiple into one category if proposed programs in another category are not considered to \$2000.

The fund is not intended for the following:

- Food
- Entertainment expenses
- Stipends to university employees (including graduate students stipends and undergraduate wage)
