### PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Exploration of agriculture in Brazil. This program is applicable to all majors and minors in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences and to students in other majors and minors who are interested in agriculture, food, the environment, and related challenges and issues.

### ITINERARY/EXCURSIONS

- Fly into **São Paulo**, one of Brazil's major cities and a hub for agriculture
- Visit **São Paulo University, Pirassununga** (college of agriculture and veterinary programs)
- Tour agricultural enterprises such as beef cattle ranches and feedlots, dairies, commercial greenhouses, sugar cane plantations and other crops, cachaça and ethanol plants, horse farms
- Fly to **Mato Grosso do Sul**
- Stay in **Bonito**, an eco-tourism hub (snorkeling, trail riding, hiking)
- Visit **EMBRAPA** (beef cattle/forage research station) and other large farms (agro-silva, dairy)
- Tour **São Francisco farm** (horse/beef cattle) in the Pantanal, the world's largest tropical wetland

### COST

Program fee is \$3,000, which includes airfare, most meals, all lodging, and all in-country travel. Does not include tuition.
